



## Seasonal Farm Crew Member

### Our Farm:

Green Earth Harvest, a program of The Conservation Foundation, is a non-profit, organic vegetable farm which feeds over 1,000 families through our 28-week farm-share program, farm stands, and 6 local food pantries. We've sustainably farmed for over 20 years on the 60-acres of protected land at McDonald Farm, the headquarters of The Conservation Foundation, located in Naperville, IL.

Natural resource conservation, improving the health of our community, providing a safe work environment and equitable compensation for our farmers are at the core of all that we do.

### Compensation and Benefits:

- Starting pay - \$16.00/hour
- Paid holidays for Memorial Day, Independence Day, and Labor Day
- 20 hours of sick time, 40 hours of vacation time in accordance with HR policies
- 401K match, up to 3%
- Farm-fresh, organic vegetables! Crew members are highly encouraged to bring home and enjoy the vegetables they grow.

### Duties and Responsibilities:

You'll learn the ins and outs of farming as you work side by side with our experienced farm managers and crew. Daily work includes, but is not limited to:

- field and greenhouse prep.
- sowing, transplanting, trellising and cultivation
- crop/pest monitoring, applying soil amendments and mowing
- harvesting, washing, sorting, and packaging produce
- the opportunity to be trained in heavy equipment operation (tractors, tractor implements, etc.)
- working with and guiding volunteers on a various tasks
- occasionally staffing our farm stands and farmshare program pickups

### Work Schedule:

- Seasonal, Full-Time: April 3, 2023 – November 3, 2023 (with some flexibility)
- Monday-Friday: 7:00-3:30, with a rotating Saturday chores schedule from May to September.





## Successful Candidates Are:

- In good physical condition; farming requires endurance.
  - Regularly squatting, bending, crouching and lifting (sometimes over 40lbs)
  - Pulling, prying, chopping, raking, shoveling, and forking with hand tools.
- Able to effectively work in all weather conditions and in a team setting.
  - You'll be working outside in all weather: sun, clouds, wind, snow, rain, and with earth's critters. The right gear is key.
  - You'll also experience chilly mornings, hot afternoons, brilliant sunrises and awe inspired by the beauty of the farm.
- Flexible. We strive to do our best to plan ahead, however, we occasionally will need to change short-term plans to account for variables like inclement weather or harvest timing.
